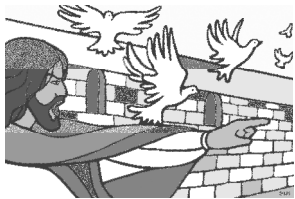


## March 15, 2009: Third Sunday of Lent

➔ On **Sunday, April 5th at 3:00 p.m.**, I would like all the members of Sacred Heart & St. Mary's parishes who have attended an ACTS Retreat to meet with Fr. Michael & me for about an hour in the Sacred Heart Family Center. We would like to share some ideas and get some feedback. Please mark this on your calendar.

➔ We will be preparing a class for Extraordinary Ministers of Communion in the near future. However, before we do that, we would like to have an accurate list of those who will be serving in this ministry. If you are an Extraordinary Minister and would like to retire or if you would like to become a new one, please call the rectory this week and let us know. Those who would like to become an Extraordinary Minister will need to meet with me before any action can be taken.

➔ Our DSA, Diocesan Services Appeal, is different from the Capital Campaign for the Diocese. The DSA is done every year for the regular operation of the diocese.

For the DSA, you can use your green DSA envelopes and put them in the collection basket or send your DSA contribution directly to the diocese. For your Capital Campaign, you send your card & donation directly to the diocese.

Our DSA goal for 2008 was \$28,367.21. The total amount contributed by 173 parishioners was \$14,048.00. Therefore, in order to meet our parish goal for 2008, we have to send the diocese \$14,319.21.

Our DSA goal for 2009 is \$26,645.60. This is based on Sunday collections. Because we have a Catholic elementary & high school, we are given a little break. Parishes without schools pay a larger percentage of their Sunday collection.

We ask you to please be generous with your DSA contribution so that we will not have to send in a large amount from the parish funds.
