From the Desk of Msgr. John

I invite all Christians, everywhere, at this very moment, to a renewed personal encounter with Jesus Christ, or at least an openness to letting Him encounter them; I ask all of you to do this unflinchingly each day. No one should think that this invitation is not meant for him or her, since “no one is excluded from the joy brought by the Lord.”

In his first apostolic exhortation, *Evangelii Gaudium* (“The Joy of the Gospel”), Pope Francis offers his sweeping vision of our Church and a “call to action” for the world’s believers. The document covers a wide range of topics, including evangelization, the priesthood and preaching, Catholic opposition to abortion, an increased openness to the roles of women and the laity, economic injustice, and more.

At the heart of his vision is a powerful invitation for each of us to embrace Christ’s call to spread the good news of the Gospel through evangelization and missionary discipleship. He notes that the joy of the Gospel and our encounter with Christ should lead us to “the delightful and comforting joy of evangelizing.”

Becoming missionary disciples means that we live and share our faith through our words and, most importantly, our *actions*. The pope encourages us to begin by renewing our relationship with Jesus Christ.

6th Sunday in Ordinary Time

"But I say to you, whoever is angry with his brother will be liable to judgment." In today's Gospel, Jesus takes the Ten Commandments to a deeper level. Instead of focusing merely on external actions, like murder or adultery, Jesus wants us to examine what is in our hearts, like anger or lust. These internal dispositions are the root cause of the outward sins. Jesus is teaching us to take responsibility for our attitudes as well as our actions.

Some may say that we cannot control our internal thoughts and feelings, or that it's unrealistic to expect us to eliminate anger and lust from our inner selves. But, as Saint Therese of Lisieux put it, Christ would not command the impossible. So it must be possible to purify our hearts and control our thoughts. But we don't have to do this on our own power. Jesus expects great things of us, but He doesn't expect us to do them alone! Through the presence of His Spirit in our hearts, we have divine assistance to accomplish this task.

When we pray to God for the gift of the Holy Spirit, He responds by filling our hearts with the gifts and fruits of the Holy Spirit-wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety, fear of the Lord, love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, generosity, gentleness, faithfulness, modesty, self-control, and chastity. When these wonderful things are present within us, the bad things have nowhere to settle. Thus we can be transformed into people who don't just live the commandments, but who love them as well.
