2017-2018 SACRED HEART CATHOLIC SCHOOL

EARLY CHILDHOOD (3K & 4K) REGISTRATION NOW IN PROGRESS – Registration for the Sacred Heart Catholic School Early Childhood (3K & 4K) program for 3 years old and 4 years old is now in progress. A child is eligible for admission into the 4-year old early childhood program (4K) if he/she has reached the age of 4 years on or before September 1, 2017. A child is eligible for admission into the 3 years old early childhood program (3K) if he/she has reached the age of 3 years on or before September 1, 2017.

You may register for the 3K & 4K Early Childhood program by coming to the school. Copy of birth certificate, immunization records, social security card, baptism certificate (if applicable) and registration fee are required for registration.

The Early Childhood program for 3K & 4K will be daily from 8:00 a.m. till 12:00 noon and will provide two options for extended care after 12:00 noon until 4:00 p.m. or 5:30 p.m. each day. The Early Childhood program is available to anyone, regardless of where you may have other children enrolled in school.
