From the Desk of Msgr. John

HEALING MISSION—Paul Rymniak is an ordinary man or so he claims. Multitudes will disagree with his self assessment, for he is known throughout the United States, Canada, Mexico and Puerto Rico. He is not a medical doctor or ordained minister or priest. He says he sees Christ working through him and he says that there is scriptural basis for his work. (Matt. 18-19)

According to Paul who credits **GOD** and NOT HIMSELF for his successes, he possesses several hundred testimonies from many medical doctors and lay people which confirm the Healings.

He makes NO claims that all who come will be healed, and he theorizes that ANGER within the ill person may prevent healing. **GOD'S** healing touch is available to everyone. Paul conducts his Healing Mission in approximately 30 churches a year, along with being the director of the Center for Peace. He also publishes a monthly newsletter that reaches thousands of people all over the world. He has had his own Catholic T.V. program which had many noted Catholics on. He has a series of tapes which includes the one tape that started his ministry ... **THE HEALING ROSARY**. With his busy schedule he has written a book about healing called ... **THE MYSTERY OF HEALING**. This book details his life in the healing ministry along with his own personal story of how it all began.

Paul sees it as an honor to be at our parish to conduct his Healing Mission, which will include the **ROSARY** and the **STATIONS OF THE CROSS**. Paul will offer his healing efforts to all who see it. So if you are in need of a **HEALING**, be it Mental, Emotional, Physical or Spiritual, you may want to consider coming to this Healing Mission, and maybe bring a friend.

A SPECIAL HEALING MISSION will be conducted, by **Paul, February 19th, 20th, 21st, 2018, at our Church**. All 3 evening will begin at **7:00 p.m.**, and the thrust of these services will be **FORGIVENESS** and **HEALING**.
