**The Baptism of the Lord**

Readings: Isaiah 42:1-4,6-7 Psalm 29:1a,2,3ac-4,3b,9b-10 Acts 10:34-38 Mark 1:7-11 or in Year B: Isaiah 55:1-11 Isaiah 12:2-3,4bcd,5-6 1 John 5:1-9 Mark 1:7-11

Jesus is the beloved Son of the Father. He is the light of the nations and Lord of all creation. To him be all glory and praise! Option: All who are thirsty come to the waters, to the Lord, the fountain of salvation. Jesus Christ came through water and blood. He is the Son in whom the Father is well pleased.

After the feast of the Baptism of the Lord, Ordinary Time begins.

**Ordinary Time**

Apart from those seasons having their own distinctive character, there remains in the yearly cycle those weeks (33 or 34) that do not celebrate a specific mystery of Christ. Rather, especially on Sundays, they are devoted to the mystery of Christ in all its fullness. This period is known as Ordinary Time (General Norms, 43).

Ordinary Time begins on Monday, January 12 and continues through Tuesday, February 24, the day before Ash Wednesday and the beginning of the Lenten season. It will resume when the Easter season ends, that is on Monday, June 1, the day following Pentecost.

**Second Sunday in Ordinary Time**

Readings: 1 Samuel 3:3b-10,19 Psalms 40:2,4,7-10 1 Corinthians 6:13c-15a, 17-20 John 1:35-42

Through baptism we have been joined to the Lord who calls us to be his disciples. How well do we listen to his voice? How willing are we to do his will?

**Third Sunday in Ordinary Time - Feast of St. Paul**

Readings: John 3:1-5,10 Psalms 25:4-9 1 Corinthians 7:29-31 Mark 1:14-20

The Ninevites heard the preaching of Jonah and repented of their evil ways thus experiencing the Lord's compassion. Do we repent when we hear the preaching of Jesus? Do we invest our lives in the world rather than in God's kingdom?

In this Jubilee Year marking the 2,000<sup>th</sup> anniversary of St. Paul's birth, the Mass celebrating The Conversion of St. Paul, apostle, as found in the Roman Missal for January 25, will be used today. The second reading of the Mass taken from the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time and the Creed is said. The Year of Saint Paul concludes June 29, 2009. Plenary indulgence available.
