THE WORD OF GOD

Fifth Sunday of Lent (Readings: Isaiah 43:16-21/ Psalm 126:1-6/ Philippians 3:8-14/ John 8:1-11)

To the exiles in Babylon, Isaiah foretells a new exodus, when the Lord will lead his people from captivity to freedom. True freedom is rooted in the person of Jesus, not in observance of the Law. It is he who challenges us to examine our own hearts before self-righteously judging others.

The Annunciation of the Lord (Readings: Isaiah 7:10-14;8-10/Psalm 40:7-11/Hebrews 10:4-10/Luke 1:26-38)

The Lord will give a sign: a child, who has come to do God's will, shall be conceived by the Spirit.

Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion (Rdgs: Lk 19:28-40/Is 50:4-7/Ps 22:8-9,17-20,23-24/Phil 2:6-11/Lk 22:14-23:56)

Jesus, humbling himself out of love for us, did not shield his face from buffets and spitting, but offered his life on the cross. He relied on his Father's love.

Holy Thursday Evening (Readings: Ex 12:1-8,11-14/Ps 116:12-13,15-16bc,17-18/1 Cor 11:23-26/Jn 13:1-15)

Before the feast of the Passover, Jesus celebrates the Last Supper in which he gives us his body and blood.

Good Friday of the Lord's Passion (Rdgs: Is 52:13-53:12/Ps 31:2,6,12-13,15-17,25/Heb 4:14-16;5:7-9/Jn 18:1-19,42)

Entrusting his life to the Father, Jesus bore our infirmities, and obedient unto death, won for us eternal salvation.

Easter Sunday: The Resurrection of the Lord (Rdgs: Acts 10:34a,37-43/Ps 118:1-2,16-17,22-23/Col 3:1-4/Jn 20:1-9/

Lk 24:13-35) On this day of days, we offer a joyful sacrifice of praise to the Father who raised his Son from the dead. Let us be intent upon the life Christ offers us. Christ our Passover who has been sacrificed.

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

All pastors in our diocese received this letter this week from our bishop. I want to share it with you.

Dear Friends in Christ,

Through God's grace, our diocese has eight seminarians. A young man may spend seven to nine years in the seminary. Our diocese will hold the first of its annual collections on Holy Thursday to help fund the education of our future priests. GENERATIONS OF FAITH (GOF):

Our next GOF will be Sunday, March 21, 2010 after Mass at the Rectory/Religious Education Center and should last until about 1:30PM. All generations are encouraged to attend. We will continue our discussion of Catholic Social Teachings with "Solidarity". "As the U.S. Catholic Bishops explain, 'Our culture is tempted to turn inward, becoming indifferent and sometimes isolationist in the face of international responsibilities. Catholic social teaching proclaims that we are our brothers' and sisters' keepers, wherever they live. We are one human family, whatever our national, racial, ethnic, economic, and ideological differences. Learning to practice the virtue of solidarity means learning that 'loving our neighbor' has global dimensions in an interdependent world.'" (Sharing Catholic Social Teaching, USCCB, 1998, 5-6). One of the concepts that GOF participants will learn about this month is "Living Simply So Others May Simply Live" as Jesus tells his disciples to do in Matthew 6:19. Won't both parishes join GOF in our ministry by placing a "Solidarity Box" in your home where you might collect money, fold, books, toys, videos, clothes, shoes, linens, etc. that can be donated?

Please be sure to bring your snack or lunch and drink. There will be a brief Confirmation Meeting immediately after GOF. We look forward to seeing you for another fun-filled learning experience about your faith.

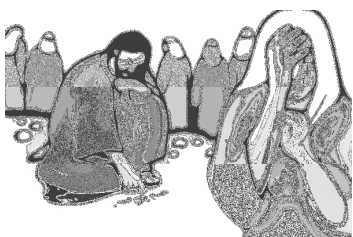
