#### FROM DESK OF MsGR. JOHN

I invite all Christians, everywhere, at this very moment, to a renewed personal encounter with Jesus Christ, or at least an openness to letting Him encounter them; I ask all of you to do this unfailingly each day. No one should think that this invitation is not meant for him or her, since “no one is excluded from the joy brought by the Lord.”

In his first apostolic exhortation, *Evangelii Gaudium* (“The Joy of the Gospel”), Pope Francis offers his sweeping vision of our Church and a “call to action” for the world’s believers. The document covers a wide range of topics, including evangelization, the priesthood and preaching, Catholic opposition to abortion, an increased openness to the roles of women and the laity, economic injustice, and more.

At the heart of his vision is a powerful invitation for each of us to embrace Christ’s call to spread the good news of the gospel through evangelization and missionary discipleship. He notes that the joy of the Gospel and our encounter with Christ should lead us to “the delightful and comforting joy of evangelizing.”

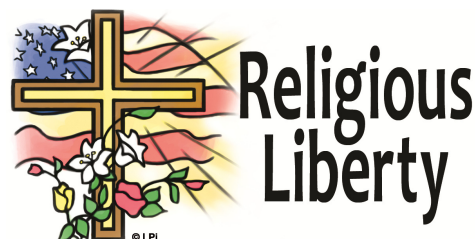
