An "oracle of consolation" regarding the restoration of Israel finds its fulfillment in the person of Jesus, our merciful high priest. His healing of the blind man witnesses to the inauguration of the kingdom.

Let us rejoice in all the men and women, blest in the eyes of the Lord, who celebrate the heavenly liturgy. They stand in God's holy place and sing of the love the Father has bestowed upon them through the blood of the Lamb.

First Friday

Readings: Wis 3:19 Ps 23:1-6 Rom 5:5-11 or 6:3-9 Jn 6:37-40

As suggested: The souls of the just are in God's hands. Christ, the Good Shepherd, died for us while we were still sinners. He is the resurrection and the life. If we have died with him, we shall also live with him.

Rooted in ancient Christian tradition (2nd c. and Tertullian), St. Odilo of Cluny (1 Jan.) established a memorial of all the faithful departed in 988. It was accepted in Rome in the 13th century.

Thirty-Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

Readings: 1 Kgs 17:10-16 Ps 146:7-10 Heb 9:24-28 Mk 12:38-44 or 12:41-44

The Lord provides for Elijah's needs as the widow of Zarephath shares with him from her want. Her generosity is mirrored in the widow in the temple who gives from her poverty and not from power, privilege, or excess. In Jesus, God became poor for us, offering himself to take away our sins.

Next Sunday evening at 6:00 p.m. in the Sacred Heart Gym and next Monday morning at 9:30 a.m., in the gym, we will hold a concert for young and old alike. It will be a free will donation.

Here is a bit of description of what it will be like:

The lights dim. A brooding synthesizer swells as a thin man walks to the microphone. He whispers the first lyrics.

Moments later, the song explodes with vibrant lights and videos depicting life and love. For the next 90 minutes, Michael James Mette guides the audience through a rock concert that is passionate like a Friday night and reverent like a Sunday morning. Beyond just music, the concert has moments for everyone including: prayerful ballads, heartfelt stories, and moving testimonies.

Since May, 2013, when he began traveling full-time, Michael has played over 250 dates in 41 states. His wife, Michelle, and their 6 young children join him on tour. Michelle's perspective adds depth and the children's presence bring fun and innocence to the evening.

Providing a bridge between the sacred and the secular, Michael's latest album, *Arts + Humanity* (2015) is planted firmly at the intersection of the church and culture. *Bring Forth the Light* (2012) explores the themes of eternal life, human love, and redemptive suffering. *Always What I Need* (2010) invites listeners to the trust in God's providence.

Although music is his passion, Michael's heart is always focused toward ministry. As a cradle Catholic, he has spent most of his life sharing his creative gifts with the broader church. He has a degree in Theology and has worked in parish ministry. In his leisure time, Michael enjoys playing board games with his kids, following Cardinals baseball, cooking new recipes, and running.
