August 28, 2016, Twenty-Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

Readings: Sir 3:17-18, 20, 28-29; Ps 68:4-7, 10-11; Heb 12:18-19, 22-24a; Lk 14:1, 7-14

September 4, 2016, Twenty-Third Sunday in Ordinary Time

Readings: Wis 9:13-18b, Ps 90:3-6, 12-17; Phlm 9-10, 12-17; Lk 14:25-33

Who can comprehend the Lord's ways or conceive what the Lord intends. True wisdom leads us to acknowledge our limitations (a matter of "calculation") and our idols of materialism as we seek to follow the Lord without reservation. True discipleship calls us to forgive those who have wronged us. May we gain wisdom of heart to discern more fully our call to take up the cross of Jesus.

September 11, 2016, Twenty-Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Readings: Ex 32:7-11, 13-14; Ps 51:3-4, 12-13, 17, 19; 1 Tm 1:12-17; Lk 15:1-32 or 15:1-10

Moses intercedes on behalf of the people who had turned away from the covenant. The Lord delights not in sin, but in our turning back to him, for a contrite and humbled heart God will never spurn. He sent his Son into the world not to condemn sinners, but to save them.
