**From the Pastor's Desk:**

On February 14<sup>th</sup>, we celebrate Valentine's Day. Also on February 14<sup>th</sup>, we now celebrate the feast of St. Cyril & St. Methodius, patron saint of the Czech people. Since many of our ancestors are from that particular part of Europe, we should honor these saints in a special way and know something about them.

**Sts. Cyril & Methodius.....**

Sts. Cyril & Methodius were brothers who are honored as missionaries to the Slavic peoples. Their work of teaching and laboring among them during the mid and late ninth century is still evident today. They left a heritage in language and liturgy especially. The strength of the Slavic faith goes back to the missionary efforts of these holy brothers. Cyril was a monk and a priest, and Methodius was, for a time, governor of a Slav colony, and then became a monk, abbot and later bishop.

Their missionary efforts met with frustrations, difficulties, and unjust accusations of heresy. This was due largely to their use of the vernacular (Slavic) language in the liturgy. Their efforts and courageous acts have enriched the spiritual and liturgical lives of the people of a vast area of Eastern Europe: Bulgaria, Bohemia, Southern Poland, and Yugoslavia. The cultures of these places are indebted to them as well.

St. Cyril died in Rome in 869, while St. Methodius continued his work for another fourteen years. He died on April 6, 884.

**Lent is upon us.** Ash Wednesday, February 25<sup>th</sup>, is the beginning of the Lenten season. I would like to bring to your attention some of our Traditional Catholic Lenten Disciplines. I would hope that we would all strive to do our best to make this Lent a time of true spiritual growth.

**Fasting and Abstinence:** Catholics of age 14 and older abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all the Fridays of Lent. On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, Catholics from age 18-59 abstain from meat and limit themselves to one full meal each day.

**Prayer:** Catholics are encouraged to pray more during Lent, especially with Scripture. Lent is also an ideal time to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation in preparation for the celebration of Christ's Passion, Death & Resurrection.

**Almsgiving:** Moved by the sacrifice of Christ, many Christians combine almsgiving with fasting, giving to the poor the money they saved by eating, drinking or buying less as they rely more upon God's abundant grace.

## Lent 2009: Disciples on the Journey

Pope Benedict XVI has dedicated 2009 to the Word of God in Scripture. Therefore, Bishop Fellhauer is strongly encouraging all Catholics in the diocese to use *Disciples on the Journey Lent 2009* to reflect on the Sunday Scripture readings.

Make a decision to either join a *Disciples on the Journey* group in your parish, or invite your friends or family to join you in your home to share and reflect on the Word of God this Lent.
