On behalf of Fr. Michael & myself, I thank you all for your many kindnesses, gifts & prayers during the Christmas Season. I also thank everyone who helped in any way with decorating in the parish and all those who participated in special ways in our liturgies during this season.

Today we celebrate the Feast of the Epiphany, the coming of the Three Kings. An old Catholic custom is the blessing of the home at Epiphany, especially the doorways. We can bless ourselves and the rooms of the home with holy water. We use chalk to mark the numerals and letters over doorways. The chalk reminds us of the dust of the earth from which we were made. The numerals consecrate the new year. The initials remind us of the legendary names of the Magi-Caspar, Melchior, and Balthasar—and also stand for the Latin motto: Christus mansionem benedicat(“May Christ bless this house”)

Next Sunday, we celebrate the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord. The Feast of the Baptism of the Lord is the final “Christmas” feast, celebrated on the first Sunday after Epiphany and commemorates God’s revelation of the divinity of Jesus at His baptism in the Jordan River.
